JUVENILE CIVIL PROTECTION ORDER/JUVENILE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

CIVIL PROTECTION ORDER

- 10.0 An action for a Juvenile Civil Protection Order or a Juvenile Domestic Violence Civil Protection Order is commenced by filing a petition with the Juvenile Court. All filings must be on the forms provided by the Ohio Supreme Court. A packet of forms with instructions can be obtained from: A) the Juvenile Court Clerk's Office B) the Alternatives to Violence Center, and C) the Ohio Supreme Court website (www.supremecourt.ohio.com).
- 10.1 The Court Clerks, Court Personnel, the Magistrate, and/or the Judge are not permitted to provide legal advice or to assist with the completion of any required forms.
- 10.2 Petitions for Juvenile Civil Protection Order must be filed between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. Any petition filed after 12:00 p.m. shall be deemed filed on the next court day.
- 10.3 Petitions for Juvenile Domestic Violence Civil Protection Order must be filed between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. Any petition filed after 12:00 p.m. shall be deemed filed on the next business day.
- 10.4 If an *ex parte* hearing is requested, the Petitioner (person seeking a protection order) must be available on the day of filing of the Petition between the hours of 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. The *ex parte* hearing will be heard as the Court is able to provide the hearing on its docket. If the Petitioner is not present when the Court calls the case for

the *ex parte* hearing, the request for *ex parte* relief will be denied, and the Petition will be scheduled for a full hearing as provided by law. If the Court is unable to hear the Petition for *ex parte* relief by 4:00 p.m. on the day it is filed, it will be heard on the next day the Court is in session.
